

**GREYTHORN PARK  
PROPOSED CODE OF BEHAVIOUR**

1. To abide by the Club rules and guidelines at all times.
2. To play and promote sport according to fairplay and to the best of your ability.
3. To present yourself according to the dress code and behaviours which reflects on the club and on the juniors.
4. To encourage juniors by example and instruction in fair play and skill aid technique.
5. To be in control verbally and in gesture even at times of provocation, injustice and high emotion.
6. To enjoy the social privileges that the Club provides but not abusing them and there-by jeopardising your own and others' health and wellbeing.
7. To show responsibility for the Club facilities and equipment and to assist in its housekeeping and maintenance.
8. To welcome visitors and spectators to matches and functions thereby promoting goodwill. The Club room at Greythorn Park is 50 metres from the public barbeques and the children's playground. This shared area is an opportunity for the Cricket Club members and other park users to meet.
9. To be aware that the Club is in a residential area and that voice and general noise are more audible at night than during the daytime.
10. To appoint a responsible person from the Committee of the Cricket Club to supervise and close on time.
11. Nominate a contact from the cricket club to resolve any arising problems. Michael Crooks has accepted to fill this role.
12. Complaints from residence, the contact will be the Secretary of Greythorn Park Special Committee.
13. Drinking outside of Pavilion to take place only on pavement area between the north side of the pavilion and the garden bed.
14. To ask liquor suppliers to deliver more often, less liquor, to minimise storage of liquor at all times.

15. Hours of Liquor License are as follows:  
Sunday: The club to apply for a special liquor license for the two days required during the season

Tuesday:

6pm to 10pm

Thursday:

7pm to 10pm

Saturday:

5pm to 11pm

The lights must be out half an hour later and everyone must leave.
